Title, recommend to Grand Camp to encourage the United States Treasury, for featuring Elizabeth Wanamaker Peratrovich on the \$10. Note.

WHEREAS, The United States Treasury is collecting nominations of women who were champions for democracy to be featured on the redesigned \$10. Note, and

WHEREAS, Elizabeth was a driving force in the Alaska civil rights movement and she fought for the rights of all Natives, almost 20 years before the passage of the United States Civil Rights Act in 1964, and WHEREAS: Elizabeth, as Alaska Native Sisterhood Grand President played an instrumental role in Alaska becoming the first organized government in the United States to end legal discrimination, and whose impassioned plea as the final speaker to the Alaska Territorial Senate addressing the Alaska Civil Rights Bill in February 1945, was considered decisive in the bill's passage, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Alaska Native Brotherhood, Camp #1 and the Alaska Native Sisterhood #4, support this resolution and we further direct the Grand Camp ANB/ANS to communicate with and urge the Alaska State Legislature in the ANS Centennial Year of the founding of ANS, recommend to the U.S. Treasury that Alaska Native Sisterhood Grand President Elizabeth Wanamaker Peratrovich be selected to be featured on the \$10. Note; and agree unanimously.
