Notice is hereby given that the 105<sup>th</sup> Alaska Native Brotherhood and Alaska Native Sisterhood Grand Camp will meet in convention at Portland, Oregon from *Thursday, October 5, 2017 through Saturday, October 7, 2017*. Registration will begin the evening of Wednesday, October 4, 2017 and continue on the morning of Thursday, October 5, 2017 at Monarch Hotel and Convention Center.

This Grand Camp will be hosted by ANB Columbia River Camp 49. The land that we will gather on in Portland is the ancestral lands of the Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde, the Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs, Burns Paiute, The Confederated Tribes of Coos, Lower Umpqua and Siuslaw Indians, The Confederated Tribes of Siletz, the Cow Creek Band of Umpqua Indians, The Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla, the Coquille Indian Tribe, the Klamath Tribes, and all Native peoples of the area.
