Title: Bar commercial sales of Alaska Seaweed, Kelp

WHEREAS, The Asian markets are requesting to take 1.6 billion pounds of kelp and seaweed out of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, Export and commercializing our Native traditional foods and our environment; and

NOW BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the Alaska Native Brotherhood and Alaska Native Sisterhood Grand Camp meeting in Juneau, Alaska, October 5-8, 2016, request State Department of Fish and Game, Southeast Alaska legislators, and the U.S. Department of Agriculture and all appropriate agencies that seaweed and all species of kelp not be distributed for commercial interest in Alaska.
