NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, The ANB and ANS, assembled in convention October 2018, request their Grand Officers to join with tribes, agencies, and organizations to further the hiring and advancement of qualified Alaska Natives within all Alaska Native communities and institutions, working to achieve a more widespread practice of employee mentoring in an effort to improve the appeal of local hire candidates.
